

L & L Music Studio – Policy Student Copy (Private Lessons)

Private lessons are scheduled for a set time each week, negotiated by the parents, student, and instructor.

Tuition:

Tuition is divided into three semesters:

Fall Semester..... September - December

Spring Semester.... January - May

Summer Semester ...June - August

Payment is due at registration. There are three payment options available:

1. You may pay the full tuition at registration
2. You may pay $\frac{1}{2}$ of the tuition at registration and the other $\frac{1}{2}$ within 30 days from the beginning of the semester.
3. You may pay $\frac{1}{3}$ of the tuition at registration, make the second payment of $\frac{1}{3}$ 30 days from the beginning of the semester, and pay the final $\frac{1}{3}$ 60 days from the beginning of the semester.

Private lesson fees:

\$17.50 per half –hour / \$35.00 per hour

In addition to the tuition price there is a \$60.00 enrollment fee per family due once a year. This will cover any books or materials the student will need throughout the year.

Events:

Special events and Festival fees may be required during the course of the year. Parents will be notified of these fees prior to the event. Festival entry fees must be paid by the deadline given; students cannot be registered for any festival without an entry fee. The registration fees vary between \$15.00 and \$25.00 per event. Events planned on your scheduled time will be considered a lesson, whether the student participates or not.

Schedule conflicts:

The studio's policy is as follows: Make-ups will only be offered in a class setting every third Saturday of the month. The student will need to let the teacher know of his/her attendance in these classes. During bad weather days these are considered "Acts of God" and will not be rescheduled. Events planned on your scheduled time will be considered a lesson, whether the student participates or not. There are no refunds or cash credits given regardless of the reason for the missed lesson.

Parents are encouraged to entertain themselves during the student's lesson, as interruptions and distractions detract from the lesson. Students are expected to bring all the proper materials needed for a successful lesson. Students are required to have an instrument for daily practice.
